

UltraTime: Employee Login, Main Menu and Time Entry Features & Functions



Accessing UltraTime Employee Login

1. Log in to InsideND.nd.edu and search for ultratime in the search bar.



2. Click on **UltraTime: Login**. **TIP:** Save this as a favorite.



Employee Main Menu Screen Overview



- <u>Balances:</u> Shows your balances of <u>Vacation</u> and <u>Incidental</u> time used and available for the pay period.
- Time Off: Takes you to the screen to view or request time off. This may be used for Vacation, Incidental, Personal, Holiday, etc.
- Punches: Shows you your recent time punches and paid hours for the last week. Included are the Date, Start Time, Stop Time, Position, Elaspsed Hours, Adjusted (Lunch) Hours, and Paid Hours.
- 4. Time Entry: Takes you to the screen where you log your hours worked.
- 5. Prev. Pay: Show the total hours per day earned on your last pay check.
- Schedule: If you work in a position that has a schedule, it shows you
 your schedule for the next 7 days. NOTE: If you do not have a schedule
 for your position, it shows "OFF" for the days.

Time Entry Screen Overview



- Apply: This will update any additions, deletions, or edits you made to a record.
 Hitting the Enter key will perform the same function.
- 2. Cancel: This clears any additions or edits that you are about to enter.
- 3. Pay Period Section: This selects the pay period or dates that are being shown.
- **B:** Current pay period, (-1) is the last pay period, (-2) is two pay periods prior. **NOTE:** You may only add or edit time on the current pay period.
- 4. Help: Brings you to the UltraTime Educational Materials section of website.
- 5. **Back:** This brings you back to the **Main Menu**.
- 6. Print: Prints the record shown on your screen.
- 7. <u>Calendar:</u> This will take you to the full year calendar <u>Time Off</u> screen where you can enter time off in the future beyond the current pay period.
- 8. **Summary:** Shows the current summary of **Vacation** and **Incidental** balances.



- 1. Day and Date: Day and date of the week.
- 2. **Delete:** Once time is entered, a check box appears to remove it if needed.
- 3. sv: This tells you the status of the time record.
- 4. Start and Stop: Employee's start and stop time.
- 5. Lunch: Time deducted for a lunch or break.
- 6. Paid: Total hours worked for this record. (This is automatically calculated.
- 7. Position: Identified where your hours will be charged.
- 8. **Comment:** You can enter a short comment regarding your time.

The entry fields shaded in grey are for absences.

- 9. **Delete and sv:** These act the same as for the time entry.
- 10. Absence: Drop down to select your absence code.
- 11. Hours: Enter the number of hours of the absence for that day.
- 12. **Position:** Drop down for the position that the absence is to be charged to.
