Nonresident Alien Student Employees
Bangladesh**

Note: If you are a nonresident alien student from the country listed above, and would like to claim treaty benefits, please complete this attachment in addition to Form 8233.

I was a resident of Bangladesh on the date of my arrival in the United States. I am not a U. S. citizen. I have not been lawfully accorded the privilege of residing permanently in the United States as an immigrant.

I am temporarily present in the United States for the primary purpose of studying at the University of Notre Dame, which is a recognized educational institution.

I will receive compensation for personal services performed in the United States. This compensation qualifies for exemption from withholding of federal income tax under the tax treaty between the United States and Bangladesh in an amount not in excess of \$8,000 for any tax year.

I have not previously claimed an income tax exemption under this treaty for income received as a teacher, researcher, student or trainee before the date of my arrival in the United States for this purposes without first returning to Bangladesh and resuming residence and physical presence before returning to the United States.

Under the penalties of perjury, I declare that to the best of my knowledge and belief, the above statements are true, correct, and complete.
